

Why participate?



- □ All agreed that it was important to do something now (window of opportunity, no one is against sustainable measures)
- ☐ The precinct scale is very suitable for sustainability measures
- We believe that a shared & codeveloped solutions are more efficient and less costly than individual solutions
- ☐ All parties were convinced that a turnover is really possible only by doing it together
- ☐ Business opportunity: the idea for a programme like this was low risk and attractive: experimenting on small scale to create innovative reproducible solutions for cities




Three key statistics




- In order to meet Paris' climate goals, we need to reduce the amount of carbon emissions by 95% by 2050
 - 40% of the total primary energy consumption —and corresponding emissions- worldwide is being consumed in the build environment
- 2.
- In the Netherlands, there are approx. 7.600.000 households. Annually only 50.000 households are added, therefore newly added buildings won't fully replace the existing built environment in more than 150 years


Renovating/ adapting the existing built environment is crucial to meet the climate goals set at the Paris accord!


Project example 1: Climate adaptive roof de Doelen
